ONTARIO COUNTY SUPPORTS MIKE SIGLER FOR CONGRESS IN THE 22ND DISTRICT

GENEVA April 06, 2022 – With recent endorsements by the City and Town of Geneva Republican Committees, Ontario County Republicans are squarely behind Mike Sigler for Congress from the 22nd District.

Sigler, a Lansing Republican, has been a Tompkins County Legislator for 12 years total, serving as interim chair briefly in 2020. He also works for Park Outdoor Advertising.

The new 22nd District includes all of Onondaga and Tompkins counties and parts of Cayuga, Cortland, Madison, Ontario, Schuyler and Seneca counties. Ontario becomes the seventh county to endorse Sigler.

“If the current congressional maps hold, Ontario will have three congressmen representing it,” said Trisha Turner, chairwoman of Ontario County Republicans. “We have a strong field of candidates and our committees have been working tirelessly in a short timeframe to get them on the ballot. I’ve known Mike for years and he has supported our county and held the fort in Tompkins. We are excited to support him.”

Sigler would represent the City and Town of Geneva.

“Geneva is the entryway to the 22nd District and we know that Mike won’t forget us,” said Pat Riley, chairman of the Town of Geneva Republican Committee. “He already knew the town and city and we know he won’t forget us. He’s been coming to Ontario County Republican events for years and we’d be proud to have him as our congressman.”

“I know every town, every village,” Sigler said earlier this year in announcing his candidacy for Congress. “We will be there for the voters of the new district. We will meet the challenges they are facing with inflation, public safety and a return to normalcy after Covid-19.”
